Curly Scarf This is a crochet class where beginners will be comfortable.

Wed. 10-12, Sept. 17 and Oct. 1 Or Sat. 9:30-11:30, Sept 20 and Oct. 4

Class fee: \$20

Crochet Market Sac This is a great easy to carry bag using 2nd Time Cotton.

Wed. 10-12, Sept. 24, Oct. 8, 15 Or Sat. 9:30-11:30 Sept. 27 and Oct. 11, 18

Class fee: \$25

Crochet Drawstring Bag Sarah has designed this bag. It takes up little space of its own and it has a big appetite.

Wed. 10-12, Oct. 22, 29 and Nov. 5, Or Oct. 25, Nov. 1, and 8.

2 at a Time Socks It's hard to sit down and start that second sock; two socks on one needle may be the answer. Students must have made a sock and be familiar with sock architecture

Class fee: \$35

Basic Sock A man's sock on double pointed needles with larger than sock yarn is a good way to start. Check with the shop for information about gauge.

Sat. 1-3, Nov. 1, 15, 22. Or Thurs. 2-4, Nov 6, 13, 20

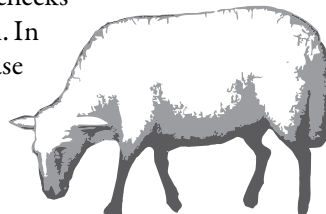
Class fee: \$35

Beginning Knitting Classes for adult and children (8 years old at least) are offered on your time schedule. You choose the days and times; all hours and days are available if the teacher is available. Children's class consists of 4 (1 ½ hour) sessions, \$40. The adult class is 4 (2 hour) sessions \$45. Needles and yarn are provided for use in the class.

CLASSPOLICY Class size is limited. Payment (checks or cash please) must be made at time of registration. In order to have the proper materials available, please register a week before the beginning of the class. "Materials needed" are your responsibility. Please purchase before the first class meeting. A 10% discount is offered for all materials used in class.

I am indecisive, a lace shawl, a beaded scarf or leg warmers are a possibility. Feel free to join either of us, call and find out when we will be working (no charge if materials have been purchased at SWF).
